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*Etymology.* The modern English word "Hebrew" is derived from Old French Ebrau, via Latin from the Greek Ἑβραῖος (Hebraios) and Aramaic 'ibr̄y, all ultimately derived from Biblical Hebrew Ibri (????), one of several names for the Israelite (Jewish and Samaritan) people. It is traditionally understood to be an adjective based on the name of Abraham's ancestor, Eber, mentioned in ...

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
